A peeled tomato of Italian origin, grown in Campania and packaged in a 450 g can

DESCRIPTION	Peeled Napoli tomatoes immersed in tomato pulp, sourced from controlled cultivation from seed to harvest and hand-processed; enriched with a basil leaf
APPEARANCE	The shape is oval and elongated, with firm and low-water content flesh
TASTE	Sweet and aromatic
PRODUCER	Casa Marrazzo - Pagani (SA)
OUR SELECTION	The Marrazzo family are "artisans of good": a family-run artisanal business dedicated to preserving and innovating the ancient art of preserves, inextricably linked to the culture of the territory. We are in the Agro Sarnese Nocerino, the valley that stretches from Vesuvius to the Gulf of Naples, between the sea and the Lattari mountains: the land of San Marzano. It is here that the Marrazzo family produces various lines of preserves inspired by the most authentic Southern tradition, with respect for the environment - utilizing clean energy, recycling water and packaging, and employing electric vehicles for sourcing local raw materials - and for the people who work in their home
CURIOSITY	The tomatoes, sourced from controlled cultivation from seed to harvest, are selected by skilled hands, hand-peeled, and packaged. Processed within a few hours of harvesting, they retain all the properties and aromas of the sun-ripened raw material
SUGGESTIONS	Designed for those seeking hand-peeled tomatoes of Campanian origin; unlike San Marzano, Napoli peeled tomatoes have tomato sauce added
